Car sharing required if final numbers exceed 16

There are Toilets at the Station but NO catering facilities

HEALTH & SAFETY: REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY TO THE TOUR

- The Loco Shed & Workshop is a construction site and, for any visit, there can be work ongoing with power tools and areas that we may not be allowed to enter from a safety point of view on the day. We have to ask for permission to enter on the day.
- ***We do not allow access to anyone not wearing shoes or boots (anyone wearing sandals will be denied entry), nor do we allow any wheeled devices due to hazards on the floor and very narrow walkways. There are some steps to negotiate so everyone would need to be fit enough for this. There are no seats in the location.***
- We try to limit the number for each guide to between 8 and 10 persons but can cope with two groups at the same time, say 16 - 20.

The tour cannot promise access to any footplate unless there is an engine adjoining a platform in one of the sheds (and that is subject to a ruling on the day, by the guide, in collaboration with the Shed Foreman), for which there can be no exceptions.
